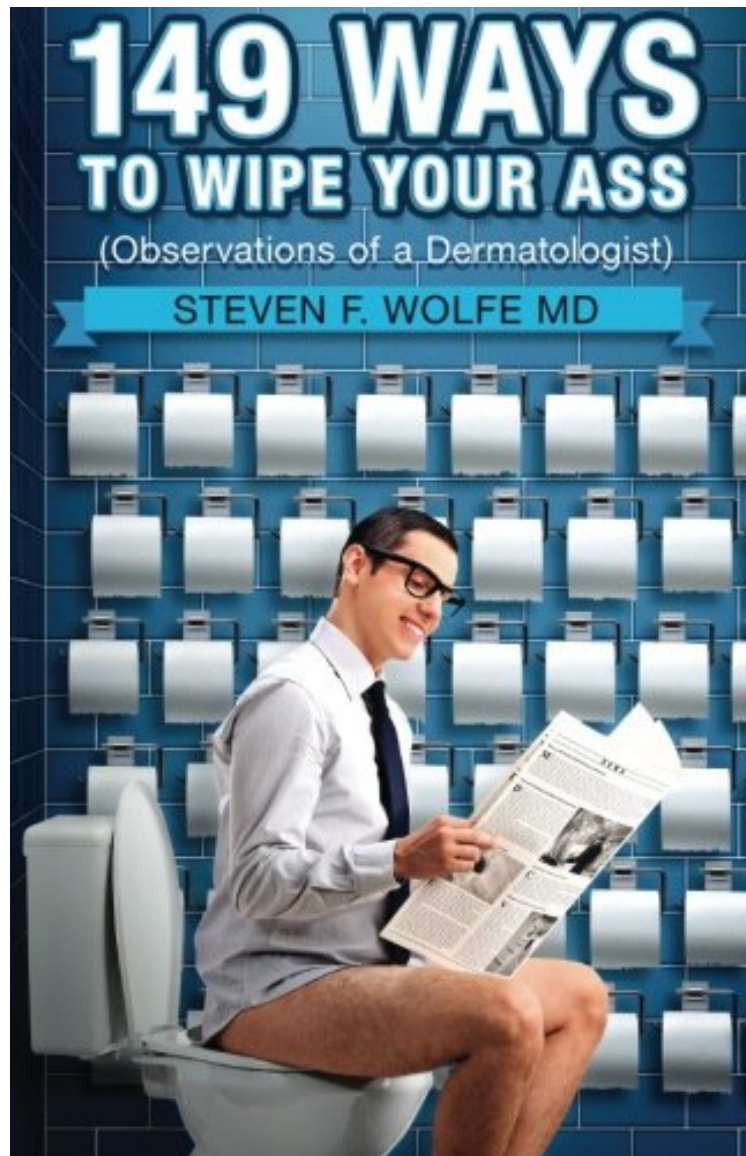


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149 Ways To Wipe Your Ass: Observations of a Dermatologist
