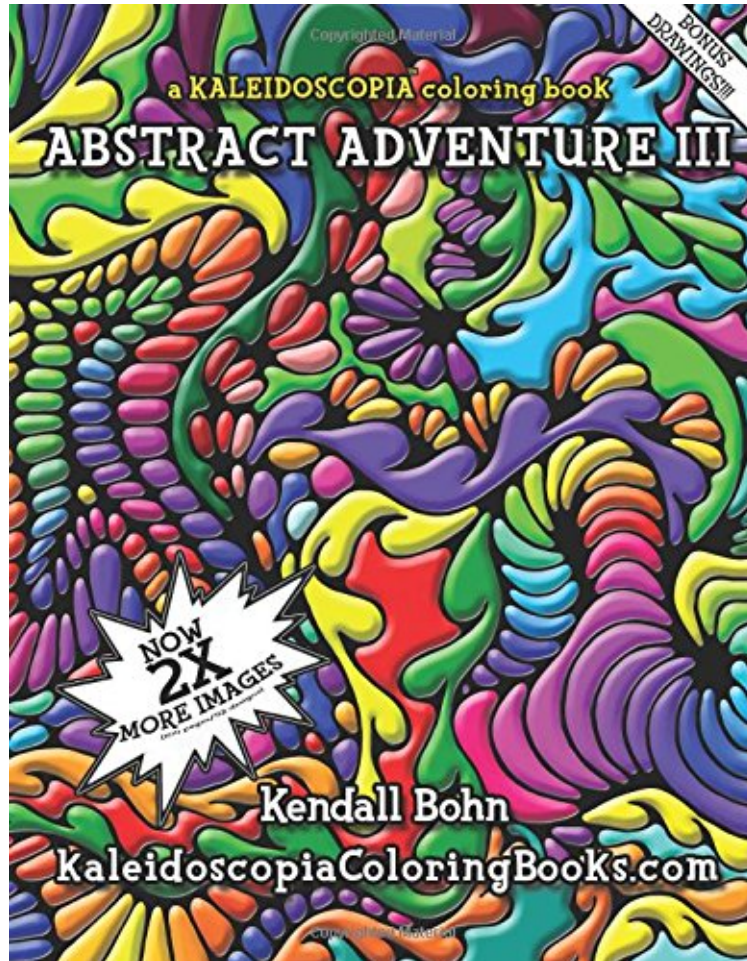

I wish I had, because this book isn't to my taste. The spaces are much too large, you have to use wide markers instead of thin ones. It doesn't do much for de-stressing, each one only takes minutes to complete. More for kids. Of note, the pages are one-sided, which is good, and the designs repeat themselves.
