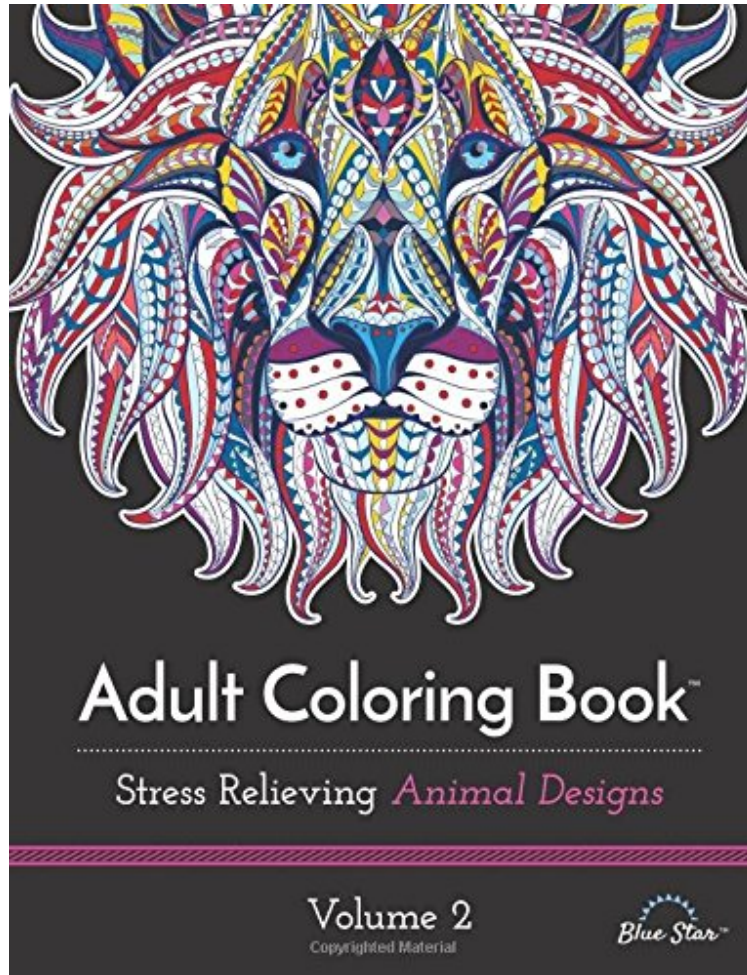

I hope it is of assistance to you. This is the second volume of Animal Designs by Blue Star. The designs are quite lovely and are full of intricate twists and turns. There are a number of distinctive design styles which makes me think that there are more than one designer involved with drawing these 33 animals. Some of the designs are bold with broad strokes of the pen while others have an almost delicate quality to them. The book is printed on a decent quality of paper and, thankfully, the designs are printed on one side of the page

with the backside left blank. That means I can have my choice of types of medium to color them with but I will definitely put a piece of freezer paper or cardstock behind the page as I work. While the pages are not perforated, it doesn't appear that it will be difficult to remove them from the binding. The designs are centered on the page with lots of blank space left on all sides, so you won't get a cramped hand while trying to color in the last bits next to the binding. There is a large assortment of animal designs, including the lion on the cover, wolf, seahorse, ram, peacock, owl, swan, and even a pig. There are so many more that you will probably find several of your favorites included. I love the relaxation that I obtain when I have been coloring. It is almost a form of meditation for me. I focus on the design and let everything else release from my thoughts. It is a wonderful way to end the day on a good note. 33 of 33 people found the following review helpful. I was very excited when I saw a new second volume had been published. The illustrations here are somewhat less complex than the first book. My main issue with the first one was some of the areas were way too small to fit my colored pencils in. Here, I think this problem has been rectified. Some of the designs are a lot less complex and from glancing at it, I think you can actually color all the areas in. Some of the designs are very simple. There is an odd one of a peacock that look somewhat ragged. I'm not sure how it made it into the book. I'm attaching a picture of it here. There are a lot more big cat designs in this. There also are a few wolves, more birds, giraffes, horses and a pig. A good selection of various kinds of animals. I like the texture of the paper in the first book more. All markers and some Gel pens leak through the paper, I place a sheet of paper under the page I am coloring to prevent damage to the next image. 3. Most of the illustrations are very detailed and some are diabolically detailed plus a couple simply detailed. 4. This book is perfect for Colored pencils, Ultra fine markers, or Gel Pens.
