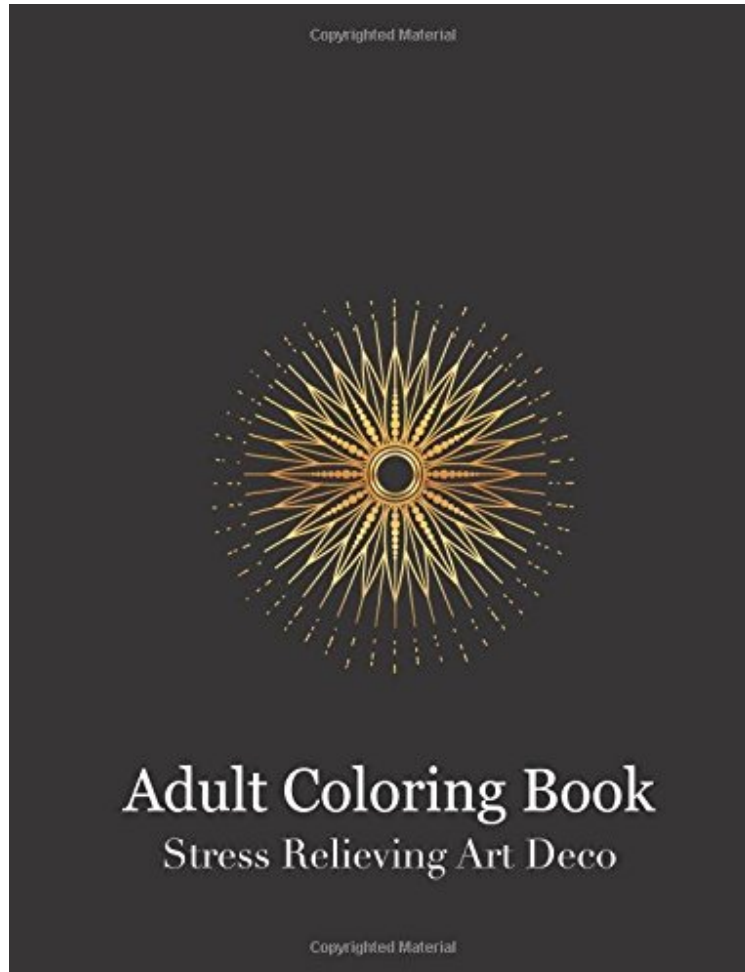

Cover picture is not representative of other imagesBy Jackie CooperThis is an excellent coloring book, it is well made, the illustrations are one per page, on nice paper and the printing is perfect. The art style and illustration types vary (see below). The art work is flowing and intricate throughout the entire book.The cover picture is not representative of most of the pictures in the book, there are only three illustrations including the cover picture in that style. See below for list of styles and examples.This is a very nice coloring book to add to your coloring library, or a perfect gift for adults, college students or older children.1. 54 Illustrations printed one per page (The back of each page is blank) on heavy weight, bright white paper.2. This book is very well made. The texture of the paper is excellent, with colored pencils it grabs the color and blending is easy with little pressure on my blending pencil, the paper is

thick enough for me to use my stylus to create lines to color over. The printing is perfect providing crisp lines.3. All markers and some Gel Pens leak through the paper so place two sheets of scrap paper under the page you are coloring to prevent damage to the next picture.4. The pages are not perforated, but the illustrations on each page do not extend to the binding so they are easy to cut out. I also tore one out and it was easy to get a straight line tear.5. The illustrations include a few simply detailed, many very detailed, and diabolically detailed.6. You will want to use Gel Pens, Ultra Fine Markers or Colored pencils with most of the illustrations in this book. The Illustrations include:1. 3 illustrations including the cover that are similar to the cover, women in artistic poses.2. 8 rectangular or square images that vary in size with spaces left in the center and some other areas, great for adding your own designs to the images.3. 20 illustrations covering most of the page of geometric shapes, from a couple simple ones to complex shapes.4. 10 illustrations that remind me of the old style of wall paper.5. 14 miscellaneous illustrations that vary in complexity detail and design and include square doily type mandalas, a city skyline, a swan, and more.6. I am adding examples of different types of illustrations for you

Helps if you appreciate the Art Deco style/1920s history. Research on what Art Deco is before you buy this- "Art Deco is an elegant style of decorative art, design and architecture which began as a Modernist reaction against the Art Nouveau style. It is characterized by the use of angular, symmetrical geometric forms." It does contain repetitive designs. I wish it came with a PDF to reprint favorites. Some images are not full page.
