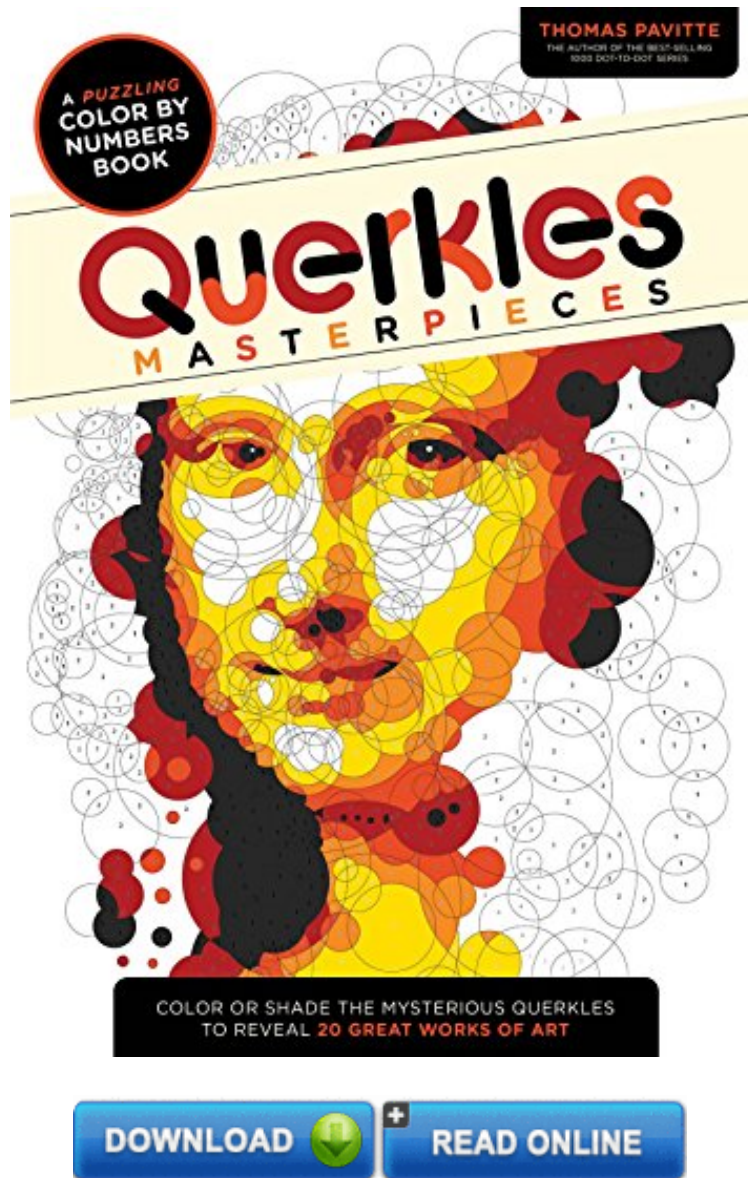

Pictures have numbers between 1 and 5, along with blank circles. You are not given the colors to use, but choose your own five colors, with 1 being the darkest and 5 the lightest. Because the picture is composed of circles, unless you peek in the back, you don't know what the picture will be. I recommend not peeking so your color choices aren't influenced. I have been using gel pens and the color does not bleed to the back of the page. The instructions are clear and the pictures are fun to uncover as you color. At first I was a bit skeptical as the numbers are a little small. In fact, I would say that the size of the numbers is the weakest part of this product. This is however necessary to add detail and depth. I wouldn't recommend this for someone who has trouble with very small print. My sister thought all the bubbles were a bit dizzying.
