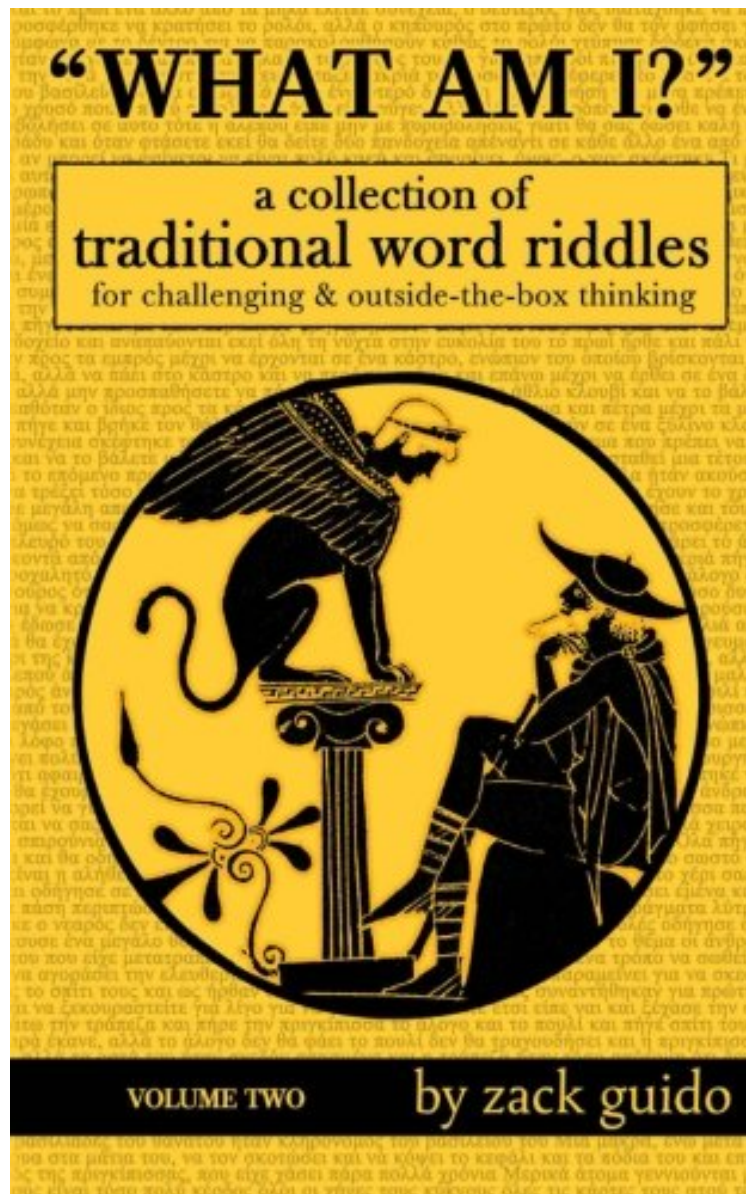

This serves as an expansion of the "what am I" riddle explored by the author in his previous installment. Though it really does not matter which volume you start with, I recommend starting with Volume One and then picking up Volume Two afterwards. The author offers up several famous riddles from literature in the first volume, which provides a very unique perspective on this type of riddle- that is the only reason I recommend starting there. The difficulty is about the same as the first volume as well, so do not buy this expecting more "advanced difficulty" riddles. Instead, this volume provides yet another set of solid riddles that you can toss around with your friends and family or simply try out on your own. One thing I would like to note that another reviewer of Volume One has pointed out as well: the author made a very intelligent decision about the formatting of the answers in the book, taking full advantage of the ebook format. Each answer is on its own page, which is linked to from the riddle itself (and the answer links back to the riddle). However, if you are reading the ebook with two pages showing in column format, just be aware that you will see two answers (since you are looking at two pages). Thus, I recommend only viewing this book in the view that allows one page on-screen at a time to fully appreciate what the author has done to prevent you from ruining other answers.

This is the second volume of a collection with 75 more fun, challenging, and satisfying wordplay riddles! A drastically different yet essential counterpart to my first collection of riddles, "Of Course!", these are easy-to-remember and fun-to-share word riddles that describe some object, thing, or place. Typically they follow a limerick-inspired rhyming structure and sometimes have pretty out-of-the-box answers. This book is filled with a handful of classics and many new and original riddles that you can be sure you've never heard before. The difficulty ranges from easy to quite difficult, but never are these riddles so cryptic and "tricky" that you won't be able to figure out the answer with enough thought. Even the simple ones feel good to solve. They are designed to be satisfying, tight, and fulfilling. It is my hope that not even one of these riddles leaves a feeling of "well that was stupid" or "that doesn't make any sense". They are meant to be written so that as soon as you think of the solution, you are completely sure that that is the correct answer! I suggest starting with Volume One if you haven't read that yet!
