Some of the ads include used toilet paper rolls given away for free, and ads asking for help from cats who have certain hobbies, such as swatting puzzle pieces around the room. Peppered through "Whiskerslist", are ads from Mittens McMullen, Attorney at Law. He advertises for all kinds of cases, such as disturbance of the peace and invasion of privacy. His slogan is "Extending My Claws...So You Don't Have To". Besides ads of all kinds, "Whiskerslist" offers forums where cats can voice their opinions on all subjects related to cats. Of course, the book would not be complete without personal ads, which include cats that are looking for special relationships. Ms. Bailey is the award-winning writer of the "Catladyland" blog. This blog won the 2011 Pettie Award for the Funniest Pet Blog/Blogger.
